NOTE: A person wilfully making a false statement in a statutory declaration is liable to a penalty of \$2000 or imprisonment for 6 months, or both.

Notes for Guidance

1. Applicants for Dual Residency status

- must declare reason/s for application for Dual Residency status,
- must declare bona fide intention to be resident/s of the NT,
- must provide evidence of current NT residential address, and
- must be the sole or joint owner/s of a Northern Territory (NT) registered private motor vehicle that is to be garaged in their NT residence.

2. Nominated contact address for the service of notices

IMPORTANT: Please ensure you have a reliable contact address for your notices. Non-receipt of notices will not be accepted as an excuse for not responding to them. Any 'returned to sender' mail received by Motor Vehicle Registry may result in the revocation of your Dual Residency status.

3. Supporting documents

- Northern Territory residency documents supporting your claim should be attached to this statutory declaration i.e. contract of purchase, current lease agreement, council rate notice, land tax valuation notice.
- A copy of your interstate drivers license should be attached to this statutory declaration.

4. Conditions for Dual Residency status

The Registrar of Motor Vehicles reserves the right to withdraw Dual Residency status at any time. It is the responsibility of dual residents to ensure that all notices received are actioned.

5. Interstate Legislative Requirements

Whilst Dual Residency status allows you to maintain NT registered motor vehicles, it provides no indemnity from other legislative requirements elsewhere in Australia. It is in your interest to make yourself aware of any local restrictions or legislative requirements of other jurisdictions which apply to your NT registered vehicles.

Warning

Persons who by false statement or misrepresentation to obtain or attempt to obtain registration or renewal of registration are liable to a penalty not exceeding \$2000 or imprisonment for 6 months under the [Motor Vehicles Act](#).

The Registrar of Motor Vehicles is required to collect information for Registrations, Licenses and Permits under Section 92 of the NT [Motor Vehicles Act](#).
