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## **Notes for Guidance**

This statutory declaration (Receipt) is required to satisfy the requirements of;

- NT *Uncollected Goods Act*
- NT *Motor Vehicles Act*
- NT *Taxation (Administration) Act*

This statutory declaration must be completed and presented to MVR accompanied by Form R35 - Application to Transfer Vehicle Purchased under the NT *Uncollected good Act*.

Stamp Duty is calculated at a rate of \$3 per \$100, or part thereof. For further details, contact your local MVR.

## **Warning**

Persons who by false statement or misrepresentation, obtain or attempt to obtain registration, renewal of registration or transfer of a motor vehicle are liable to a penalty not exceeding \$2,000 (companies \$10,000) or imprisonment for 6 months under the NT *Motor Vehicles Act*. Under Section 59 of the NT *Taxation (Administration) Act*, persons who falsely declare the sale price and or the market value of a vehicle are liable to a penalty of \$5,000.

## **Privacy Statement**

The Registrar of Motor Vehicles is required to collect information for Registrations, Licenses and Permits under section 92 of the NT *Motor Vehicles Act*.
