## **New \$300,000 school bus interchange open for business**

The Territory Government has spent \$300,000 on a new and much-needed bus interchange in the rural area.

The Member for Goyder, Ted Warren, inspected the new Cox Peninsula school bus interchange today.

“There are six buses every morning and afternoon passing through the interchange, servicing the Humpty Doo, Berry Springs, Darwin River/Southport, Livingston and Cox Peninsula areas,” said Mr Warren

“We have positioned the new interchange back from the busy Stuart Highway to provide a much safer environment for the 400 plus students who use the interchange every day.

“The dedicated school bus interchange also has a designated area for parents and guardians to drop off and pick up their children”.

The new interchange has been operating for the past couple of weeks and has been well received by parents and students.

“Ensuring primary and high school students are able to travel to and from school safely is a high priority for the Martin Government,” said Mr Warren.

“This interchange plays a vital and integral part of the school bus transport system in the rural area.”
