### Free buses for AFL and V8 Events

The Northern Territory Government will make available dedicated public transport buses for spectators to attend the AFL game on 16 June and the V8 Supercars on 22, 23 & 24 June.

Passengers attending these events can travel on the bus FREE of charge.

For the **AFL NT Game between Western Bulldogs and Fremantle**, services will commence from 5.00pm and continue at half hourly intervals until 7.00pm. The free buses will run from Gilruth Avenue (via Cullen Bay and Darwin Interchange), Casuarina Interchange and Palmerston Interchange. Return services will depart from Marrara Sports Ground from 9.30pm and continue at regular intervals subject to demand.

Spectators attending the **V8 Supercar event** can take advantage of the numerous public bus services dedicated to the event. On **Friday 22**, a direct service will run between Darwin City and Hidden Valley commencing from 9.00am with services throughout the day and the last bus departing Hidden Valley back to Darwin at 5.30pm.

On **Saturday 23 and Sunday 24** buses will run from Darwin (various routes), Nightcliff, Casuarina, Palmerston and the Rural area. Services will commence from 7.00am and continue at regular intervals throughout the day. Return services will operate at scheduled times until mid-afternoon and thereafter as demand requires following the last race.
