



Free bus service to Military Museum to remember bombing

The Department of Planning and Infrastructure will be running free buses to the East Point Military Museum in commemoration of the World War II bombing of Darwin.

The museum is running an Open Day on Sunday, 17 February 2008 in remembrance of the attacks by Japanese bombers on 19 February 1942. The two raids killed more than 240 people.

The free buses will leave the Darwin Bus interchange for the museum at two hourly intervals from 9am to 1pm. They will depart the museum at two hourly intervals, beginning at 10am.
