

UPGRADE OF FOG BAY ROAD

FACT Sheet

The Northern Territory Government is delivering a progressive sealing project for Fog Bay Road.

Since 2001 more than \$8.2 million, including the 2009-10 budgeted works, has been committed to upgrade and seal 33 kilometres of Fog Bay Road across six projects.

A current project to seal and upgrade 4.6 kilometres is underway and will be completed in 2009.

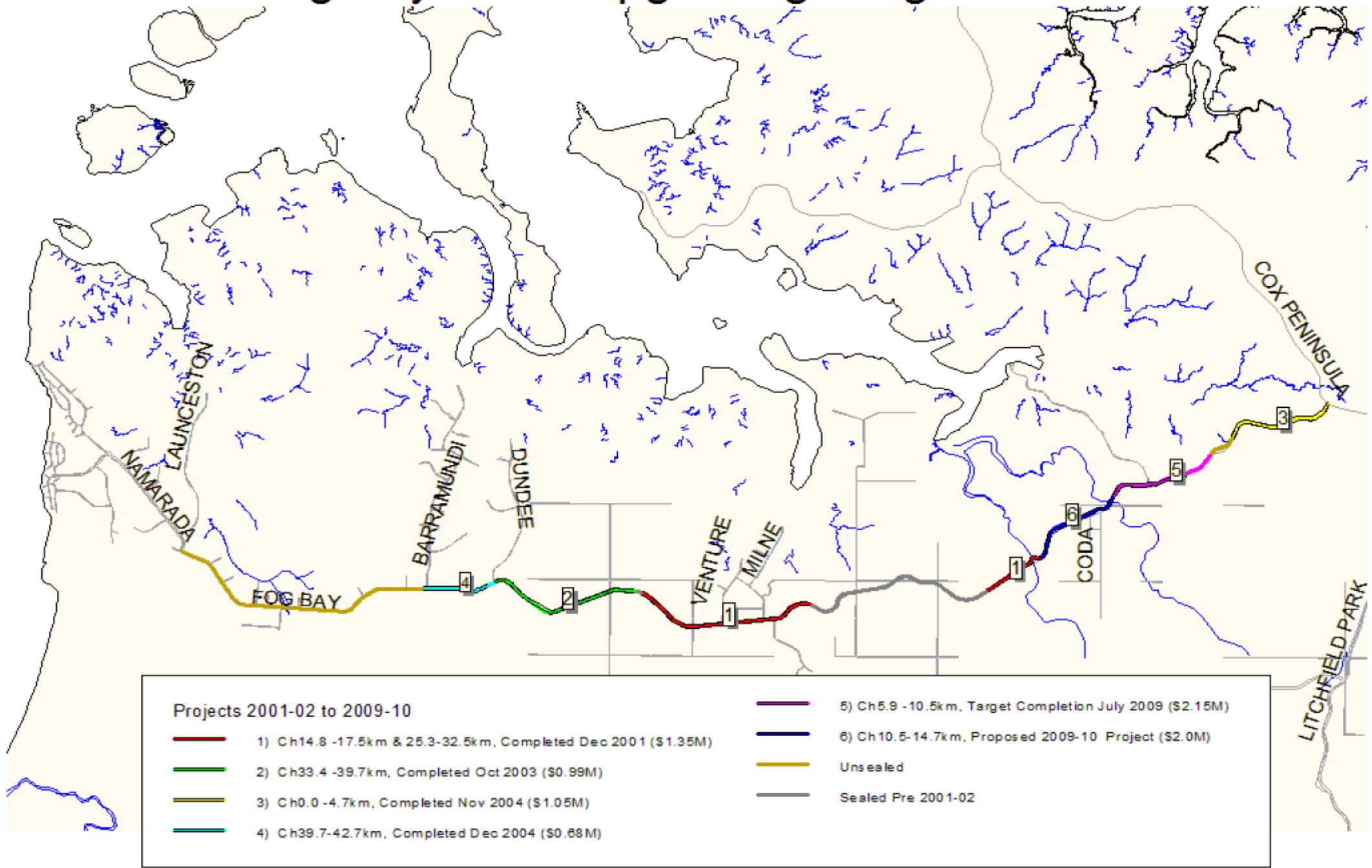
Budget 2009 provides \$2 million to continue these works across a further 4.5 kilometre section which adjoins the existing upgrading project. This project will commence in 2009.

The priorities for the staged works to seal Fog Bay Road have been determined by the Department of Planning and Infrastructure in consultation with the Dundee Progress Association and the Bynoe Settlers Association. This program has also taken into account an assessment of safety issues and traffic counts.

The remaining items are prioritised in order as completion of sealing to Namarada Drive, with the last item being the realignment and upgrading of the stream crossings.
